



MEAN SAT Scores Compared to College Readiness Benchmarks








Comments: The data above illustrates Frontier International Academy's performance on the Reading and Writing and Math portions of the 2015-16 SAT test. The results are displayed in both table and chart form and provide Frontier International Academy 2015-16 data compared to the 2015-16 Wayne RESA's and the 2015-16 State's. The percent of students proficient as well as the MEAN test scores reveal that Frontier International Academy students are below the State and ISD averages and below the College Readiness Benchmarks. Data highlighted in red indicates below benchmark scores.


Frontier International Academy was ranked in the 56th Percentile for the 2014-15 school year and was released from the State's Priority School List on September 1, 2016. Sometime later this fall the State will release the rankings based on the above 2015-16 testing data.






Comments: The data above illustrates Frontier International Academy's 2015-16 performance on the Reading and Math Northwest Evaluation Association's Measure of Adequate Progress (NWEA/MAP). The charter contract measures school growth using this assessment, setting the goal of at least 50% of students reaching their growth targets. The graphs above show that students at Frontier International Academy are, on average ("School Average"), meeting their reading and math growth targets. The students at Frontier International Academy are, on average, not meeting their math and reading gradelevel achievement targets using this assessment.

Quadrant charts on the next page further illustrate the growth and achievement levels of the students at Frontier International Academy. The markers on the charts represent the other schools that Bay Mills Community College charters. The quadrant illustrations can be used to compare Frontier International Academy with other schools authorized by Bay Mills Community College.
