



Percent of Students Proficient on Math M-STEP








Comments: The data above illustrate Keystone Academy's performance on the English Language Arts and Math portions of the 2015-16 Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP). The results are displayed in both table and chart form and provide Keystone Academy 2015-16 data compared to the 2015-16 Wayne RESA's, the 2015-16 State's, and the academy's 2014-15 results. Keystone Academy continues to outperform both the State and Wayne RESA. Data highlighted in green indicates an increase in proficiency rates from 2014-15 to 2015-16, while data highlighted in red indicates a decrease.


Keystone Academy ranked in the last published Top to Bottom List (for the 2013-14 school year) in the 50th percentile group. The academy was not on the recently released bottom 5th percentile group for 2014-15. Sometime later this fall the State will release the rankings based on the above 2015-16 testing data.






Comments: The data above illustrates Keystone Academy's 2015-16 performance on the Reading and Math Northwest Evaluation Association's Measure of Adequate Progress (NWEA/MAP). The charter contract measures school growth using this assessment, setting the goal of at least 50% of students reaching their growth targets. The graphs above show that students at Keystone Academy are, on average ("School Average"), meeting their math and reading growth and grade-level achievement targets using this assessment.

Quadrant charts on the next page further illustrate the growth and achievement levels of the students at the Keystone Academy. The markers on the charts represent the other schools that Bay Mills Community College charters. The quadrant illustrations can be used to compare the Keystone Academy with other schools authorized by Bay Mills Community College.
