










Comments: The data above illustrate Laurus Academy's performance on the English Language Arts and Math portions of the 2015-16 Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP). The results are displayed in both table and chart form and provide Laurus Academy 2015-16 data compared to the 2015-16 Ingham ISD's, the 2015-16 State's, and the academy's 2014-15 results. The data highlighted in green on the above tables indicate an increase in proficiency rates in 2015-16, while the data highlighted in red indicate a decrease.


Laurus Academy ranked in 18<sup>th</sup> percentile group in the last published Top to Bottom List (for the 2013-14 school year). The academy was not on the recently released bottom 5<sup>th</sup> percentile group for 2014-15. Sometime later this fall the State will release the rankings based on the above 2015-16 testing data.






Comments: The data above illustrates Laurus Academy's 2015-16 performance on the Reading and Math Northwest Evaluation Association's Measure of Adequate Progress (NWEA/MAP). The charter contract measures school growth using this assessment, setting the goal of at least 50% of students reaching their growth targets. The graphs above show that students at Laurus Academy are, on average ("School Average"), meeting their math and reading growth targets, the reading grade-level achievement targets, and approaching the math grade-level achievement targets.

Quadrant charts on the next page further illustrate the growth and achievement levels of the students at the Laurus Academy. The markers on the charts represent the other schools that Bay Mills Community College charters. The quadrant illustrations can be used to compare the Laurus Academy with other schools authorized by Bay Mills Community College.
