<p>STUDENT PERFORMANCE</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The academy has clearly established academic goals 2. Student achievement scores are increasing 3. There is 1 year gain in student achievement for students enrolled for at least 3 years at the academy 4. There is no citation of corrective action being taken by the State 5. The academy board receives monthly academic updates
<p>FINANCIAL STABIITY</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The academy has effectively managed its finances 2. There is a fund balance of 10% or trending positively 3. The annual audit has not identified any concerns to the authorizer
<p>ACADEMY GOVERANCE</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The academy board attends training sessions provided by BMCC 2. The academy board holds monthly meeting 3. Minutes reflect that policies and procedures are approved and in place 4. There are no Open Meeting Act violations 5. The board regularly reviews student achievement 6. The board regularly reviews the financial statement
<p>COMPLIANCE</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All required documents are submitted to Epicenter on time as required
<p>PARENTAL/GUARDIAN INVOLVEMENT</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A yearly survey is provided to parents/guardians of students attending academy 2. Survey results show trends that assist the academy in improving 3. Results of parent, staff, and student surveys are filed in Epicenter by June 30
<p>PROFESSIONAL STAFF</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All teachers and paraprofessionals are fully certified and highly qualified 2. There is sustainable professional development for all staff and administrators

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BOARD ANALYSIS OF ACADEMY	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The board prepares a written Executive Summary which represents a complete understanding of academy's strengths and areas of improvement2. The board indicates anticipated plans for addressing areas that need improvement3. The board indicates anticipated plans for the growth of the academy4. The Board addresses this question: “Why should we be reauthorized?”
